IMPORTANT:

- **BRING YOUR DRIVING LICENCE WITH YOU**
- **ENSURE YOUR ARMS AND LEGS ARE COVERED WHEN ON TRACK**
- **BRING YOUR HELMET (or hire one on the day, but these cost £5 per HOUR to hire)**

We have again organised 4 exclusive track sessions for Club Members as follows:

- Session 1: 11.30am (a **BLUE** session), assemble at 11.15am
- Session 2: 12.30pm (a **BLUE** session), assemble at 12.15pm
- Session 3: 2.15pm (a **GREEN** session), assemble at 2.00pm
- Session 4: 3.30pm (a **BLUE** session), assemble at 3.15pm

From 8.30am on the day, your personal "Track Pack" will be available to collect from the Club Marquee. Many of you will be familiar with its contents and what you need to do, but for everyone's benefit this briefing outlines

- The contents of your pack
- What you need to do on the day to ensure your track time goes smoothly

TO GET ON TRACK

- 1) Purchase and retain this pass. To be shown at Driver Briefing and given up prior to circuit use.
- 2) Have your car noise checked.
- 3) Attend briefing (at least 30 minutes prior to your session)
- 4) Collect wristband and fix on your right wrist.
- 5) Queue for your Track time.
- 6) Read all the Track Rules & Indemnity - overleaf.
- 7) Follow the Track Officials Instructions.

ONLY VALID FOR DATE AND TIMES SHOWN ABOVE

- 8) Obey the Track Rules.
- 9) Driving Licence - Only sign this pass if you have a full current driving licence. We reserve the right to demand proof of licence at any time.

Sign this card, show at the driver briefing, hand in at the assembly area and show wristband. No wristband, no circuit access.

MOTORSPORT CAN BE DANGEROUS AND MAY INVOLVE INJURY OR DEATH

You must read and agree to the following declaration and paragraphs below which are designed to create a legally binding relationship in return for your being allowed to participate.

1. I will satisfy myself (by sighting lap or otherwise) before taking part that the venue and track is acceptable to me with regard to its features and physical layout (unless prohibited to do so).
2. By taking part I accept the risks involved including the risk of injury or death.
3. I declare that I am competent to take part
4. I declare that my vehicle is safe, complies with the regulations and is fit to use for the activity for which I have attended today.
5. I am aware and accept that other participants will be on the circuit at the same time.
6. I am not taking any drugs (prescribed or otherwise) nor am I under the influence of alcohol either of which will impair my ability to take part.

7. I have read, understood and will comply with all circuit regulations, any supplementary regulations and final instructions for this event given by the organiser and/or venue owners and/or any person nominated on their behalf.
8. If under the age of 18 years, my parent/guardian has read the above and signed opposite my name to confirm agreement with the declaration.
9. In the event of any accident I hereby agree to save harmless and keep indemnified Castle Combe Circuit, Castle Combe Racing School and Castle Combe Action Days LLP and supporting companies associated with their event, their officials, representatives, agents and members each and every one of them from and against all actions, costs, expenses, claims and demands in respect of injury, fatal or otherwise, loss or damage to person or property of myself or my guests accompanying me however caused or arising out of or in connection with my entry or to my taking part in any training course or event or not occasioned to be reason of negligence of the said bodies, officials, representatives or agents.
10. I declare that my vehicle is safe and in a fit and proper condition for use in circuit driving and where such use shall take place on roads as defined by law that the use of the vehicle is covered by insurance as required by the Road Traffic Act or equivalent legislation. I confirm that I hold a Full UK (or non UK equivalent) Car Driving Licence.

TRACK RULES

PLEASE READ OUR FULL GUIDANCE NOTES

- 1) Wearing of Crash Helmets is compulsory.
- 2) Arms and legs must be covered – no shorts.
- 3) Seat belts must be worn. *(Some Classic cars may be exempt for parades only)*
- 4) Front seat passengers must be aged 16 years or over and a minimum of 5'2" *(Drivers should check their insurance)*
- 5) Ensure that your vehicle is in suitable condition for circuit driving, is up to MOT test standards and meets our strict sound regulations - 100db(A).
- 6) Always drive within your limits.
- 7) **Only overtake on the right, and on the straights.**
- 8) Do not overtake on corners, braking area or within red zones.
- 9) Check mirrors.
- 10) Indicate clearly and early if pulling into pit lane.
- 11) Obey Flag and Light Signals.
- 12) If you spin or drive dangerously you may be refused further track time.
- 13) End of session chequered flag, continue around circuit, slow down, indicate and enter pit lane.
- 14) Drive slowly in the paddock area.
- 15) All drivers must hold a Full UK driving licence and produce it if required.
- 16) Drive safely and enjoy yourself.

Flag Signals & Traffic Lights



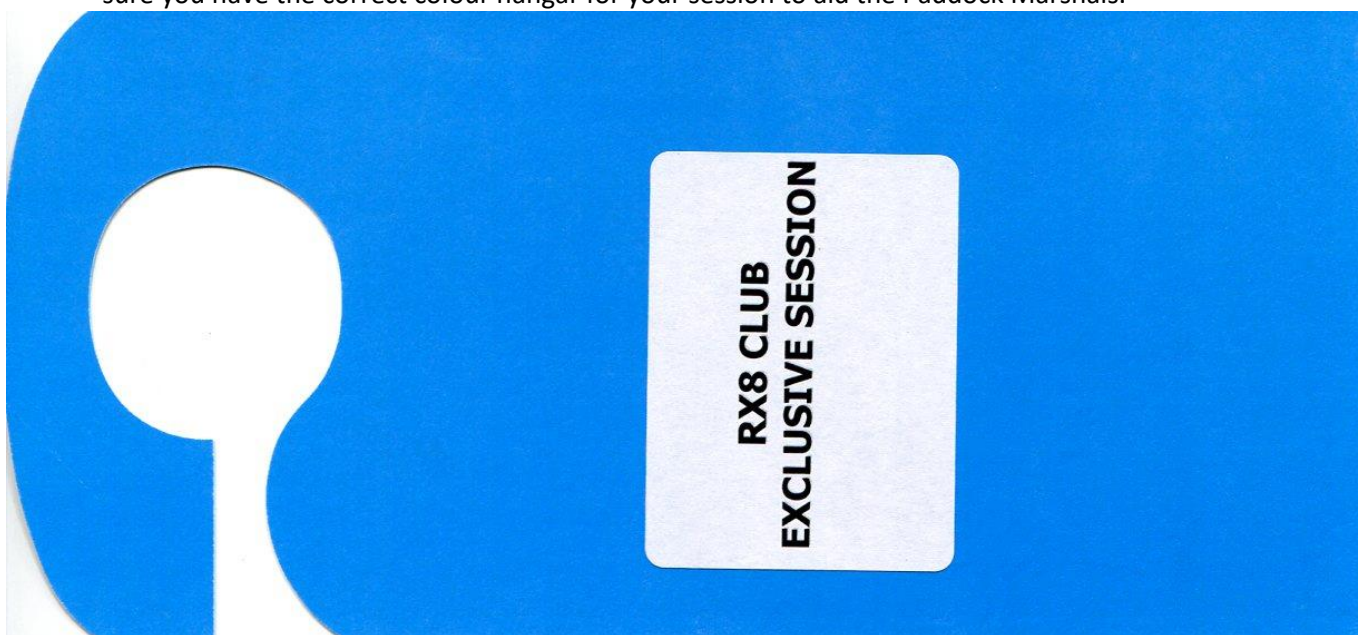
CONES: Yellow – Braking, Red – Turn-in, Green – Apex

YOU WILL BE BLACK FLAGGED IF YOUR CAR IS DAMAGED OR IS LEAKING FLUID

REFUNDS – Our refund policy is as follows

- A. Once booked a full refund (less 25% administration fee) will be given if all passes are returned a week prior to the event
- B. Refunds are not given for track passes if you miss your allocated time or briefing on the day.
- C. Refunds are not given in the event of bad weather.
- D. Club packages. Track passes are transferable, but not refundable.
- E. Advanced public. 2 hours prior to track time is required plus £10 handling fee.

- A mirror hangar for each session. NOTE: Session 1,2 and 4 hangers are IDENTICAL and **BLUE**, denoting a XX:30 session time. Session 3 Passes and hangers are **GREEN**, denoting a XX:15 session time. Just make sure you have the correct colour hangar for your session to aid the Paddock Marshals.



WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

Before the day:

Ensure you are familiar with the Track Rules (see reverse of the Track Pass), the Track Guidelines (see last two pages of this briefing) and the Flag signals and Traffic Lights. There MAY be cones present around the edge of the circuit – they are a GUIDE, but don't rely on them as they may have been nudged by a car in an earlier session.

YELLOW CONES: mark **braking** points

RED CONES: mark **turn-in** points

GREEN CONES: mark corner **apexes**

It's a good idea for first time track drivers to put a "Novice X" sign in the back window, so fast closing cars can see immediately and give more room to that car (even Conan puts one in the back!). If you are able to print this out, size about 100-120mm square and attach it inside your back window, it may help, but is not compulsory.



On the day:

- If you are arriving with a trailer then JDM Combe have advised us as follows:

"Cars arriving with trailers will be directed to the trailer parking area in Tower Car Park via the Orange Gate. Please unload your display/track car and leave your road car and trailer in the Trailer Parking Area and then proceed to your Club Stand. Trailers and non-display (road) vehicles will NOT be allowed as part of the displays"
- Get your car noise tested. The area will be signposted and it's usually near the Red Entrance. Noise testing is open from 8.00am. No rush to get this done straight away as there will be queues early on!
- Collect your track pack from the Club Marquee and complete each of the track Passes; mostly straightforward personal info but you do need to fill in your Driving License Number.
- Attend a compulsory driver safety briefing (location and time will be advised on the day). ***Those drivers on Session 1 should aim to get to a briefing asap. Briefings will be held regularly throughout the day, exact times and location TBA on the day.*** TAKE YOUR Track Pass(es) to the briefing to get your driver wristband. Drivers need only attend ONE briefing session, even if they are driving in multiple sessions. Passengers do NOT need to attend a briefing.
- Get your car to the assembly area (near the footbridge) 15 minutes before your track session time. Bring your completed Track Pass (which will be collected from you by the Marshals) and mirror hanger.

REMEMBER, to get on track:

- you must have a valid driving licence
- your car must pass a noise test
- you must have a helmet, with your arms and legs covered
- you must have attended a briefing (and got your wristband)
- you must have a completed and brought with you a "Track Pass" and appropriate colour hanger for your session time

REMEMBER, before you go on track to:

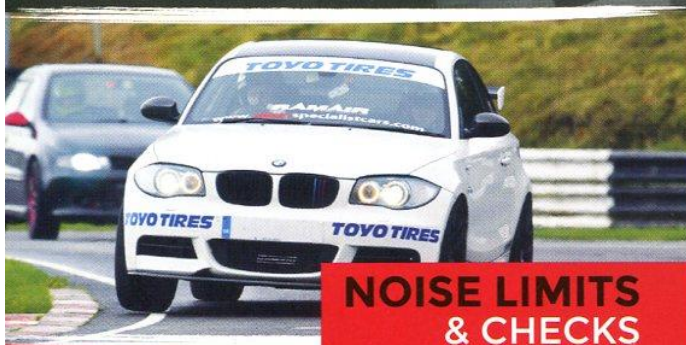
- Check your oil and coolant levels
- Check your tyre pressures
- Check your brake pads have sufficient wear left
- Ensure your engine is warmed up
- Ensure you have plenty of fuel (reckon on 7-12mpg on track)

PASSENGERS must sign on in the Strawford Centre. All-day passes cost just £5 and can be purchased on the day. Helmets are compulsory; bring your own or hire one on the day (£5 per HOUR). Arms and legs of passengers must also be covered.

GUIDELINES FOR TRACK USERS

At Castle Combe Action Days and Shows, you'll have full use of our famous circuit but remember - it's not a race! Please familiarise yourself with the rules of using the track before your day.

- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any car, driver or passenger track access for whatever reason and their decision is final.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse participation to anyone who is suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Safety briefings are compulsory at all circuit track events, even if you've done one before.
- The track is not to be used for racing, please see event website for full track guidelines. These will also be covered in your briefings.
- All drivers must hold a full UK driving license.
- Please drive slowly and take extreme caution in the paddock and parking areas as pedestrians may be walking.
- Cars must be to MOT test standard and in a suitable condition for circuit driving: ensure tyres are at recommended pressure for high speed driving, do NOT overfill petrol tanks, slick tyres are not permitted, 3 wheel cars are not permitted.
- No hand held cameras allowed in the car.
- Insurance - Circuit public liability insurance covers our customers out on track, NOT their cars. You use the circuit at your own risk.



NOISE LIMITS & CHECKS

All vehicles must be noise tested before going out on track.

The limits are enforced throughout the day and are very strict!

The standard limits are: 100d(b)A measured at 4500rpm on a static test with the sound meter set at 1/2 metre from the exhaust outlet.

You will NOT be allowed on track if these requirements are not met. NB Motorcycle engine cars are checked at 3/4 max revs with a limit of 100d(b)A.

Merlin are also open on each track day should you need further assistance, silencers or mufflers.

ACTION DAYS & SHOWS

- Display areas open from 7am for setup.
- Organiser's office open from 8am.
- Please follow the directions on your display pass to your designated parking area (whether club or public), entering only by the gate shown on your pass.
- Track passes are only valid for the date/time shown and are non-refundable.
- Noise restrictions will be enforced all day.
- We operate a YELLOW CARD system at all Action Days and Circuit Shows - dangerous drivers will be reported to the Chief Safety Officer and given a yellow card. 2 yellow cards and we BAN the car and the driver.
- Front seat passengers only in track sessions however under 16s and back seat passengers may be allowed in some parade sessions - visit the organiser's office on the day for details.
- Refund Policy:

Once booked, a full refund (less 25% administration fee) will be given if all passes are returned a week prior to the event.

Refunds are not given for track passes if you miss your allocated time or briefing on the day.

If you wish to transfer a session to a later time on the day, please visit the organisers office, please note we will require at least 2 hours' notice.

Refunds are not given in the event of bad weather.

- Getting on Track

1. You must attend a noise check.
2. Purchase and collect track passes & car hangers for your sessions from the organiser's office.
3. Complete and keep hold of your track pass.
4. Attend a compulsory driver briefing at least 30 minutes prior to your first session taking your track pass with you to obtain a drivers wristband.
5. Queue up in the assembly area 15 minutes prior to your session with your car hanger on show.
6. Follow the track officials' instructions and give up your pass/hanger on request.

FLAG & TRAFFIC LIGHT SIGNALS



RED FLAG/LIGHTS - Extreme Hazard: prepare to stop, check mirrors, slow to approx. 20mph, return to pit lane for instruction.



YELLOW FLAG/LIGHTS - Danger: slow down; prepare to take evasive action, no overtaking.

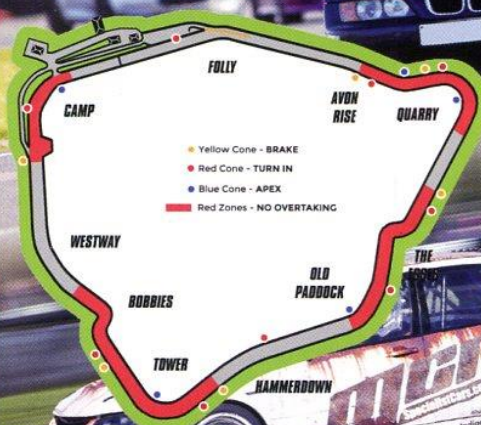


BLACK FLAG - Danger warning: either your driving or your car is causing concern to track staff, slow and return to pit lane.



CHEQUERED FLAG - End of session: use the pit lane slip road to exit the track.

CORNER MARKING CONES & RED ZONES



TRACK MARGIN LIMITS & RULES



You can drive on track asphalt up to and including the white line and on the full extent of any kerbs (marked red/white).

You are NOT permitted to put a wheel beyond the white lines or kerbs! If you do not comply with these rules you may be subjected to warnings and exclusion from using the track.
